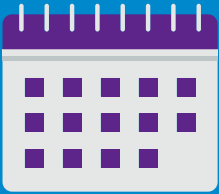

What Is It?

A daily medication you take if you're at risk for getting HIV to stop the virus from growing in your body.

How effective is it?

When used correctly,
it can reduce the risk
of HIV from sex by

99%

...and from needle
use by nearly

75%

You should take PrEP if you:



Have an HIV-positive partner



Have multiple sexual partners or a partner
who has multiple partners and you don't
know if they're HIV-positive



Don't use condoms during sex



Share needles



How long do you need to take it for?

It takes **about a week** for PrEP to build up in your system to be effective,
and you have to take it **every day** for maximum protection.
